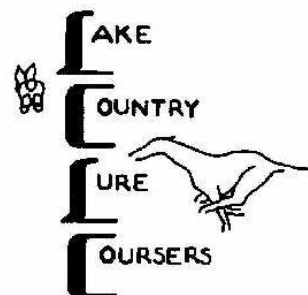
DIRECTIONS:

ENTRIES AND FEES

Entry fee: \$20 per class

Online entries are recommended, as entries are First Received, and we anticipate these trials will fill.

CLASSES OFFERED (all 4 trials)

Container, Interior, Exterior and Buried will be offered in each trial.

LEVELS OFFERED

Novice and Advanced will be offered in each element.

JUDGES

Sunday – all classes - Melissa Sowa, Coraopolis, PA
Monday – all classes – Lori Coventry, Cheektowaga, NY

STAGING AND CRATING AREA

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warmup and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing\

A **warm-up area** will be available consisting of ONE container each of Birch and Anise, and may also consist of blanks containers. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior their run.

SEARCH AREA

Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

Search Area Conditions. Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces.

Search Area Sizes will be as follows, Container Novice (250-400sqft.), Interior Novice (100-200sqft.), Exterior, Novice (200-400sqft.) Buried Novice (150-200sqft.)

RIBBONS AND TROPHIES

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place:Blue

Second Place: Red

Third Place: Yellow

Fourth Place: White

Qualifying Score: Dark Green

A **New Title rosette** will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing either an Element or a Level title.

High in Trial

Only teams who participate in all elements offered (Container, Interior, Exterior, and Buried), and qualify in each are eligible to win **High in Trial**. One High In Trial winner is chosen in each level (Novice and Advanced).

The High in Trial is determined by adding the team's faults across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team with the faster total time will win.

ELIGIBILITY

Dogs eligible to compete in Scent Work must be:

Registered with AKC, Listed with a PAL/ILP or listed with the Canine Partners (CP) program, and be 6 months of age or older.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5. Section 26 of the Scent Work

Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Spectator Area. Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide.

Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be ask to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

REFUNDS

Dogs pulled after closing because of injury, season or other medical condition may be eligible for a refund if their entry can be replaced from the wait list.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us).
