NOTE: The CAT and FAST CAT tests will have an 'Open Check-In' – this means that you can come down to the field at any time during the published hours, to avoid conflicts with your other events. When you arrive at the field to check in, we will roll call your dog, and you will be put on the running order for the next available run.

If you have entered two tests on the same day, you may run them at different times, or back-to-back (with a rest period in between).

Dogs entered in the CAT and FASTCAT tests may wear a buckle collar (no tags), coursing blanket or muzzle at the owner's discretion to aid in the retrieval at the end of the course.

Sighthounds: Trial will not conflict with breed judging in the conformation show, so you may enter both. Breeds will NOT run until after the conclusion of breed judging. Confirmation and schedule will be emailed once the conformation judging schedule is released.

ELIGIBILITY

JC, QC, Trial

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Norbottenspets, Pharaoh Hounds, Podengo, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Thai Ridgebacks, and Whippets are that are one year of age or older may be entered. All entries must be individually registered with the AKC, or an AKC recognized foreign registry, or has an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) from the AKC

CAT Test - The Coursing Ability Test is open to all breeds, and Canine Partners at least one year of age on the day of the test.

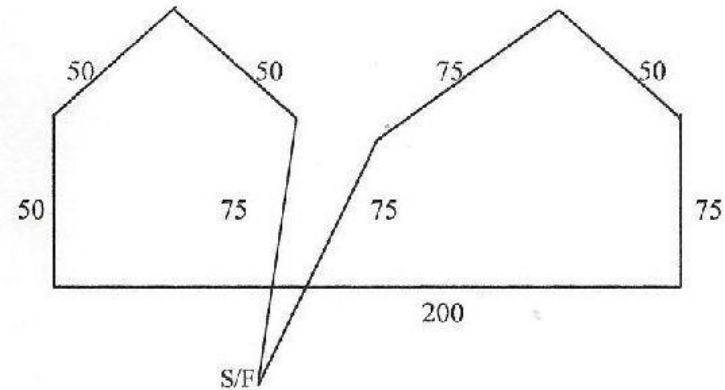
FAST CAT – The FAST CAT is open to all breeds, and Canine Partners at least one year of age on the day of the test. It is a 100 yard timed event, dogs run singly. Dogs earn points towards their titles based on their size and speed, and the Top 20 fastest dogs of each breed are posted on the AKC website.

NOTE: Exhibitors will be given the option of having a catcher at the end of

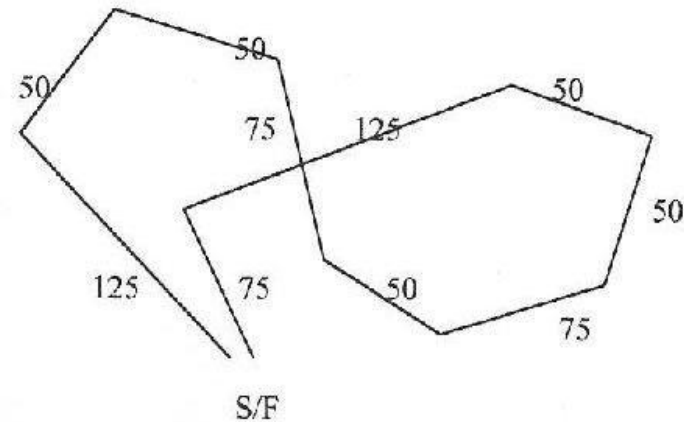
the track, or having the dog continue to chase the lure back to the beginning (total about 250 yards).

COURSE PLANS for CAT and Sighthound trial

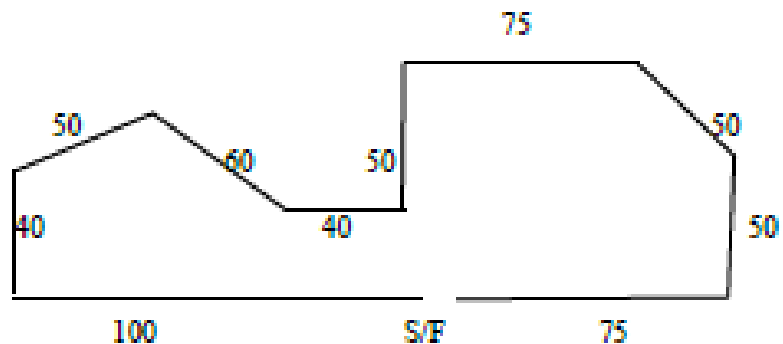
Friday 600 yards

TESTS OFFERED

To earn the **Junior Courser (JC)** title, "A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge on one date and a second certification from a different judge on a later date stating the hound complete a 600 yard course with a minimum of four turns." The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

Qualified Courser (Test): A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

To earn the **Senior Courser (SC)** title, a dog must run at four (4) trials, with a least one other hound and get qualifying scores, under at least two different Judges or judging panels. A qualifying score is 50% of the total available points from the judges. At these same trials, if a dog also wins a placement, it can earn points towards the AKC Field Championship titles.

To earn the **Master Courser (MC)** title, a dog must complete the Senior Courser title and then earn an additional twenty-five (25) qualifying scores (with competition) in either Open, Veteran or Special stake.

To earn a **Field Champion (FC)** title, your dog must earn 15 points, including two (2) first placements worth three (3) points or more under two (2) different Judges or judging panels. Points are earned for first, second, or third place depending on the number of dogs for that breed competing. A dog that has earned its Field Championship can be entered in the Specials stake where it can compete for the Senior Courser, Master Courser or Lure Courser Excellent title.

To earn the **Lure Courser Excellent (LCX)** title, a dog must be a Field Champion and then earn an additional forty-five (45) points. The title of Lure Courser Excellent is a cumulative title, each time the dog accrues an additional 45 championship points it would be eligible to receive the title level. (LCX II, LCX III, LCX IV, etc)

NOTE: FSS breeds are eligible for suffix titles (JC, SC, MC) only.

To earn the **Coursing Ability (CAT)**, a dog running alone must pursue a lure, completing the course with enthusiasm and without interruption within a given time. Dogs that pass the CAT three times will earn a Coursing Ability (CA) title. Ten passes and a dog earns a Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA) title, and 25 passes results in a Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX) title.

This test is for any dog of any breed, including mixed-breeds, as long as it is at least 1 year old and individually registered or listed with AKC

CONDITIONS

- **Hounds that are disqualified from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may not be entered.**
- Hounds must be 1 year of age or older on the day of the Trial or Test.
- Bitches known to be in season should NOT be brought onto to the test/trial grounds.
- Bitches in season, hounds with AKC breed disqualifications and lame hounds will be excused and the entry fee refunded.
- Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched after a five-minute grace period.
- Each sighthound entry will be examined at inspection for AKC breed disqualifications. Spayed and neutered hounds without AKC breed disqualifications are eligible to participate. Monorchid or cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate.
- Battery powered, continuous loop lure system will be used. Backup equipment will be available. The lure will consist of white plastic strips and/or fur.
- A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for any hound loose or interfering with the course in progress.
- A \$25.00 fine will be assessed to any owner not cleaning up after their hound.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee, and may be subject to a bench committee hearing.
