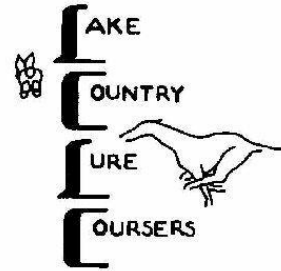

## ROLL CALL AND INSPECTION:

**Thursday, Friday, Sat: 9am – 5 pm**

### General Info

\* Try-Its will be available from 8:30 – 9 am, at lunch, and after the tests.  
\* The FAST CAT tests will have an 'Open Check-In' – this means that you can come down to the field at any time during the published hours, to avoid conflicts with your other events. When you arrive at the field to check in, we will roll call your dog, and you will be put on the running order for the next available run.

\* If you have entered two tests on the same day, you may run them at different times, or back-to-back (with a rest period in between).

\* Dogs entered in the CAT test may wear a buckle collar (no tags), coursing blanket or muzzle at the owner's discretion to aid in the retrieval at the end of the course.

**NOTE:** Exhibitors will be given the option of having a catcher at the end of the track, or having the dog continue to chase the lure back to the beginning (total about 250 yards).

## RIBBONS AND TROPHIES

**Lake Country Lure Coursers** will offer small prizes for the fastest and slowest times in each FAST CAT test.

New Title Ribbons will be available.

## ELIGIBILITY

**FAST CAT** – The FAST CAT is open to all breeds, and Canine Partners at least one year of age on the day of the test. It is a 100 yard timed event, dogs run singly. Dogs earn points towards their titles based on their size and speed, and the Top 20 fastest dogs of each breed are posted on the AKC website.

## CHAMPIONSHIP

The championship will be held on Sunday, Sept 17. In order to be eligible, dogs must be entered in at least one FAST CAT test each day on Thursday, Friday and Saturday. At the conclusion of Saturday's test, the fastest 16 eligible dogs in each Division (Under 12", 12 – 18", Over 18", Sighthounds) will be invited to compete in the Championship.

Dogs will be random drawn (within their Division) in pairs into an elimination bracket. Dogs will be run (singly), and the faster of the two dogs will advance to the next round. This will continue until only one dog remains undefeated in each Division.

No points or legs will be awarded on Sunday.

## CONDITIONS

- Hounds must be 1 year of age or older on the day of the Trial or Test.
- Bitches known to be in season should NOT be brought onto to the test/trial grounds.
- Bitches in season, and lame hounds will be excused and the entry fee refunded.
- Battery powered, continuous loop lure system will be used. Backup equipment will be available. The lure will consist of white plastic strips and/or fur.
- A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for any hound loose or interfering with the course in progress.
- A \$25.00 fine will be assessed to any owner not cleaning up after their hound.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee, and may be subject to a bench committee hearing.

### AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and, if this entry is for a lure coursing trial, the "Lure Coursing Trial Regulations" have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) agree the Club holding this trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the trial and of the opportunity to have the hound judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this Club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
